Key Advantages –

- Eliminate early season weed competition when your crop is most sensitive.
- Widest spectrum of weed control including annual grasses, yellow nutsedge, small seeded and large seeded broadleaf weeds (e.g. wild cucumber)
- Reduces pressure of tough to control weeds in the next season.
- Long residual weed control, often the only weed management measure you will need
- Optimized farm management e.g. less field entries needed during the vegetative period.
- Control of glyphosate and triazine resistant weeds.

Directions for use:

Optill™ must be tank mixed or applied sequentially with Frontier® Optima or Prowl® CS.

Application Instructions:

- Optill™ may be applied or pre-emergence and ensure at least 7mm of rainfall or irrigation occurs within 5 days after spraying.
- Optill™ should be mixed with a pre-emergent grass herbicide (e.g. Frontier® Optima or Prowl® CS) for enhanced control of grasses and certain broad leaf weeds.
- Do not apply Optill™ after the crop has germinated or “cracking” (when the crop is beginning to break through the soil) or severe crop injury will occur.

- Pre plant burn down applications should be done when the weeds are young and actively growing. Use higher volume applications when targeting dense weed populations.
- Optill™ may be applied by ground application or aerial application. Good spray coverage is important for good weed control.

Application rates:

Soyabeans - Pre-emergence - 140 grams/ha + Frontier Optima or Prowl CS.

WEEDS CONTROLLED:
